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Decoding the Denotative and Connotative Elements in Sony Pictures Animation's Short Film "Hair Love" (2019)

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ABSTRACT

The current era has witnessed significant developments in the realms of digital and technology, which have impacted every aspect of our lives, including the art of filmmaking. Not only has technology empowered actors to portray characters, but it has also given rise to animated films to give a message. A prominent scholar, Roland Barthes, proposed that the concept of semiotics could be used as a tool to uncover hidden meanings in various forms of media. The objective of this paper is to examine the denotative elements in Sony Pictures Animation's Hair Love using Roland Barthes' semiotic theory. The purpose of this study is to discuss and explain the nonverbal signs or symbols that appear in the film. The denotative elements present in Hair Love are identified and analyzed using qualitative analysis in this study. The findings of this study reveal the presence of 23 denotative and connotative elements in the movie. Overall, this study contributes to the field of semiotics by analyzing the denotative elements in a contemporary animated film using Barthes' theory. This study's findings can provide useful insights into the use of nonverbal symbols in animated films and how they can be used to convey hidden meanings to the audience.

INTRODUCTION

Digital Developments and Filmmaking

Nowadays, entertainment can be seek in many ways and many platforms such as magazines, e-book, music, and films. With the help of technology, it is no longer difficult to access those entertainment. They all can be accessed through gadgets which allows its user to have multipleapplications such as YouTube, Netflix, Instagram, Amazon Prime, Twitter, Spotify, and many more (Cunningham & Craig, 2019). The YouTube application user for allows its to watch and even to upload their videos on the platform. Over thousands of people rely on YouTube as their living due to the big amount of money they can received per one video. The people who post content on their YouTube channelis called a YouTuber or Content Creator. Many YouTuber works individually, as a team, organization, news media, and many more. The videos uploaded on YouTube by them are all different, depend on what YouTube channel provides.

Sony Pictures Animation is a well-known YouTube channel that produces a variety of animated entertainment for audiences around the world. Since its inception in 2011, Sony Pictures Animation has been actively uploading videos to its channel, with a total of 487 videos currently available. The studio's most recent releases include critically acclaimed films such as "The Mitchells vs. The Machines," a visually groundbreaking masterpiece, "Vivo," a musical adventure featuring original songs by Lin-Manuel Miranda, and "Hotel Transylvania: Transformania," the fourth installment in the beloved monster movie franchise. Furhter, the Sony Pictures Animation YouTube channel predominantly showcases short animated videos and compilations of animation videos. This channel aims to provide entertaining content for viewers of all ages,

leveraging the power of animation to create engaging and visually stunning works. By using YouTube as a platform, Sony Pictures Animation can reach a wider audience and engage with fans through comments, likes, and shares.

Animated videos are a dynamic and versatile form of media that employ computer-generated graphics, illustrations, and other visual elements to convey movement and change over time (Busch et al., 2020). There are several techniques that can be used to create animated videos, including traditional hand-drawn animation, stop-motion animation, and computer-generated imagery (Amini et al., 2018). Such videos serve multiple purposes, including entertainment, education, marketing, and storytelling, and can be produced in a range of styles, such as 2D or 3D animation. Filmmakers typically use a variety of tools and software programs to create animated videos, from simple and user-friendly options for beginners to more sophisticated tools for professionals. Some common software programs used for this purpose include Adobe Animate, Blender, and Toon Boom Harmony.

The proliferation of online video platforms and mobile devices has contributed to the growing popularity of animated videos in recent years (Gurvitch & Lund, 2014; Pate et al., 2020; Karakolidis, O'Leary & Scully, 2021). These videos can be easily accessed, viewed, and shared across various digital platforms. One notable example of a short animated film produced by Sony Pictures Animation is "Hair Love," which was uploaded on YouTube on December 5, 2019, with a duration of 6 minutes and 48 seconds.

The story of "Hair Love" revolves around a little girl who is learning how to style her hair while her mother, who is hospitalized due to cancer, is unable to do so. The girl stays with her father, who is also inexperienced in hair styling, and watches her mother's instructional hairdo videos on YouTube to learn how to do it herself. This short film is a poignant exploration of the power of familial love, determination, and resilience, presented through the medium of animation.

Semiotics: Symbols and Meaning in Film Studies

Saussure (1916) posited that semiotics applies to any system of signs, regardless of their substance and limits, including images, gestures, musical sounds, objects, and the complex relationships among them that constitute the substance of customs, traditions, or public entertainment. Building on this idea, Barthes (1977) emphasized the interplay between the content of a sign and the individual and cultural experiences of its users, as well as the interaction between the content's cultural context and the cultural contexts experienced and anticipated by its users.

Barthes's concept of signification includes both denotation (the lexical meaning) and connotation (the secondary meaning that emerges from social and individual experiences). Although Barthes still employs the term signifier-signified, he also introduces another aspect of signs, myths, which are signs that have become naturalized in society. According to Barthes, the concept of connotation in semiotics can be used to uncover hidden meanings. Roland Barthes was a French literary theorist, philosopher, and critic who had a significant impact on the fields of literary and cultural studies. One of his most famous theories is the "death of the author," which posits that the meaning of a text should not be determined by the author's intentions or biographical context, but rather by the way it is interpreted by the reader. Barthes believes that a text's meaning is not predetermined but rather emerges from the reader's interpretation process. In other words, the reader is an active participant in creating meaning rather than being a passive recipient of the author's intended message.

Further, Scholes (1982:35) notes that many semioticians argue that the meaning of any sign or word is entirely a function of its use in a paradigmatic context and a syntagmatic context. Sillars (1991:110) defines



semiotics as the study of signs, arguing that a sign is a physical object that refers to something other than itself and depends on recognition by a user that it could be a sign.

Semiotics, the study of signs and symbols and their meanings, has had an impact on many disciplines, including literature, cultural studies, and film studies (Withalm, 2002; Thwaites, Davis & Mules, 2018; Rutsyamsun & Sakinah, 2023). Saussure and Roland Barthes are seminal figures in semiotics. Saussure's concept of semiology emphasizes the importance of signs in any framework of communication, whereas Barthes expands on this idea by emphasizing the interaction between a sign's content and the cultural and individual experiences of its users. In addition, Barthes introduces the concept of connotation, which refers to the additional meanings that a sign may have in addition to its literal or denotative meaning. He contends that connotative meanings can reveal hidden cultural values and beliefs.

Bordwell and Thompson define several types of films in the context of animated films, including animated films, which are composed of a series of images that create the illusion of movement. One such film is Sony Pictures Animation's "Hair Love," which was released on YouTube in 2019. In this study, researcher intends to analyze the denotations and connotations of the music video in this short animated film, drawing on semiotic concepts and the contributions of scholars such as Saussure and Barthes. The study seeks to shed light on the cultural values and beliefs (Erlidawati & Rahmah, 2022), that are reflected and communicated through this animated work by examining the various layers of meaning in the film.

METHODS

This study utilized a qualitative approach and descriptive analysis to provide a thorough explanation and description of the data. According to Sugiyono (2014:207), qualitative research is holistic in the sense that it investigates the entirety of the social context under investigation, including the space, actors, and activities that interact synergistically. In qualitative research, the interpretation of the text under investigation is subjective because, as Karl Erik postulated, the process of meaning cannot be divorced from the subjective aspect that gives it significance. According to Hamad, Sudibyo, and Qodar (2001:15), such theories permit researchers to read a book subjectively due to the effect of their personal life experiences.

The analysis of a 2019-uploaded file including a short animation of Love Hair served as the primary source of research data for this study. The analysis also utilized secondary data in the form of theoretical frameworks, statistics, and information. This secondary data was collected from many sources, such as books, journals, and the internet. According to Sugiyono, data gathering procedures are a crucial phase in research because they serve the fundamental objective of data collection (2014:224). The research included two data collection methods: documentation and literature review. Documentation included watching and attentively monitoring the brief animated film on YouTube, as well as recording, choosing, and evaluating data in accordance with the employed research model. Moreover, song lyrics served as a data source for the study. According to Machmud, the literature review entailed collecting data from several sources, including technical manuals, journals, websites, and theories that could serve as research material (2016).

Roland Barthes was a French literary theorist, philosopher, and critic who had a considerable impact on the fields of literary and cultural studies. His theory was used to study the connotations and denotations in the animated video of Love Hair. One of his most well-known views is the "death of the author" theory, which proposes that the meaning of a book should not be established only by the author's goals or biographical circumstances, but rather by the reader's interpretation. To study the connotations and denotations in the film,



the researcher viewed the video and collected screenshots of scenes containing signs, then recorded the connotations and denotations based on Barthes' theory.


RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The animated short film "Hair Love" tells the narrative of a young girl who struggles to find a hairstyle that suits her. The fact that her mother, who normally helps her with styling her hair, is currently hospitalized means that the small girl will have to do it all on her own. The purpose of this study is to apply Roland Barthes' theory in order to conduct an analysis of the denotative and connotative aspects that are contained within this short animation. The purpose of the investigation is for the researcher to determine all of the possible interpretations and meanings that may be derived from the signs and symbols that are displayed in the animation. The researcher wants to provide a more in-depth explanation of the narrative, characters, and issues conveyed in the film. In the end, this research has the potential to offer insight on the ways in which the animation depicts social and cultural standards, as well as personal experiences, that are meaningful to viewers of many ages and backgrounds.



Connotation:





Connotation:



Connotation:








Denotation:


The hand on the chest

Denotation:



The hair on the mother is a sign that she has recovered from her illness. The smile on their face is indicating a happiness.


CONCLUSION
